Deanna Richards moved to our Bayshore Village neighborhood after purchasing 180 Sandpiper Lane a year ago and having the property beautifully remodeled and updated. When asked how she got here, she joked, "On a road trip across the country, my muffler fell off outside San Luis Obispo, and I decided to stay." However, there was a lot of history before and after that incident.

Deanna was born and raised in the town of Kajang, just outside Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. She is the daughter of two teachers who encouraged her to pursue a career in medicine. Instead, Deanna chose engineering and studied at the University of Edinburgh, Scotland, and returned to Malaysia to practice engineering. Two years later, with \$1000 and a small suitcase, she arrived in the United States for graduate work, earning a Doctorate in Environmental Engineering at the University of Pennsylvania at Philadelphia. Before taking a teaching job at the University of North Carolina in Charlotte, she made that fateful trip with the muffler problems across the country. While in Charlotte, she was recruited by the National Academy of Sciences in Washington, DC, to head their program on Technology and Environment. For ten years she worked on changing engineering and management practices to take environmental considerations into account and avoid costs and damage.

After ten years, she moved to the West coast (remembering the spot where her muffler fell off), consulted independently, and juggled health care needs of her parents back in Malaysia. She also began to explore other interests and found new balance and joy in her life in her volunteer efforts--first at the Piedras Blancas Light Station--and a new career as a financial advisor. Deanna is now a successful financial advisor and runs the Edward Jones office in Los Osos. During her "free time", she enjoys music, art and a wee bit of golf along with donating her time to local non-profit causes. She displays the work of local artists in her spacious office and conference room and hosts opening receptions in their honor at the beginning of each show.

Fish Bonez Restaurant

Fish Bonez opened in 2013 in the space above Rose's Landing at 725 Embarcadero. As the name implies, the menu contains a great selection of seafood specialties as well as chicken and beef entrees. Salads are prepared fresh with their own unique homemade dressings.



Because it is located on the second floor, (accessible by an elevator or stairs), the view of the Rock and Bay are spectacular.

Mutt Mitts at BaySHORE BLUFFS PARK

Dear Bayshore Village Dog Owners,

The Mutt Mitt program was established by the Morro Bay National Estuary Program several years ago to address the issue of bay pollution due to runoff of animal waste. It costs approximately \$350 per year to keep one dispenser filled with Mutt Mitts. An individual or group can sponsor a Mutt Mitt dispenser by making an annual contribution of \$350 to the program.

Several homeowners have already donated to this program. If each of us would contribute \$25 per year (a tax-deductible donation) to the "Bay Foundation", who oversees the Mutt Mitt program in Morro Bay, we could sponsor the Bayshore Bluffs Park Mutt Mitt dispenser and the dispenser would have a customized sign on it that recognizes our contribution.
